Powering Ambitions: Vocational Training Transforms Lives

BRPL's vocational training centers are transforming the lives of hundreds of youngsters from underprivileged backgrounds. In June 2024, 57 students enrolled in various training programs across eight VT centers, including specialized training for visually impaired aspirants in braille. With a total of 889 enrollments so far, these centers are helping youth realize their dreams and aspirations.

Weaving Hope: Empowering Women with Handloom Training

In the heart of Sangam Vihar JJ Cluster, BRPL, in association with SAVE, has established a Handloom Training cum Production Unit. This initiative, "Dhaga Vishwas Ka," aims to promote traditional craftsmanship, empower local artisans, and generate sustainable employment. Equipped with 4 handloom machines, 4 charkhas, 1 tana-bana machine, 2 sewing machines, and more, the unit is set to become a hub for creativity and economic growth. In June, 25 beneficiaries, primarily women, were enrolled in this program, learning to create beautiful and marketable handloom products like bed sheets, stoles, shirt fabrics, and dress materials.



Centre at Uttam Nagar

The Uttam Nagar JJ Cluster, also a home to economically weaker sections, faces challenges such as inadequate infrastructure and limited access to basic amenities. To promote traditional craftsmanship and empower local residents, BSES, has established another Handloom Incubation Centre, "Thread of Trust." The Centre features 15 handloom machines, 12 charkhas, a tana-bana machine, 10 sewing machines, and a cutting and pressing table.



Since June 2024, 22 women have been involved in training at the Centre, with a total of 82 women trained so far. The Centre produces unique handloom products such as double bed sheets with pillow covers, stoles, and kurti fabric. Additionally, a product display area and learning materials have been developed, and packaging materials for samples are being designed.



Both centers, Sangam Vihar and Uttam Nagar, reflect the company's commitment to community empowerment and the preservation of traditional crafts.



Strike a Pose: Yoga Camps Energize Our Schools

For the well-being of our teaching and non-teaching staff at government schools, BRPL organized five yoga camps, benefiting around 570 individuals. These sessions aimed to promote mental and physical health through the ancient practice of yoga, fostering a sense of peace and community among participants.

Rooting for a Greener Future: Tree Plantation Drive

BRPL is committed to not only providing reliable power but also ensuring environmental sustainability. On World Environment Day, BRPL planted approximately 150 trees in Paschim Vihar, Bhera Enclave, Raghuveer Nagar, and Punjabi Bagh. This initiative underscores our dedication to nurturing nature and preserving the planet for future generations.



Money Matters: Financial Literacy for Empowerment

BRPL's CSR programs are enhancing financial literacy among the needy by spreading awareness about financial concepts, personal finance, and money management. In June 2024, around 500 women benefited from this initiative, with 1500 beneficiaries to date, including those who have opened bank accounts and joined the formal banking system.



Crafting Futures: Self-Help Groups Empower Women

Through Self Help Groups (SHGs), BRPL is bringing social and economic empowerment to women, particularly from underprivileged sections. In June 2024, around 90 women participated in SHG activities, learning skills such as soft toy making, frock making, handicrafts, wall hangings, and bag making. These activities not only foster community but also provide sustainable income sources.

Beyond our core initiatives, BRPL has embarked on several large projects to amplify our impact, showcasing our dedication to community enrichment and sustainable development.

- 3 E-mobility of patients and their relatives at AIIMS
- 4 Old Age Home in collaboration with Healthy Aging India, an NGO run by AIIMS doctors
- 5 Maintenance of ecological parks
- 6 Handloom incubation centre for revival & enrichment of handloom & handicrafts
- 7 Holistic development of young boys and girls through sports, initially Basketball
- 8 Setting-up green crematoriums by installing electric furnaces and other facilities.
